



## ABOUT OUR WORK

Oasis Center aims to provide life-changing programs and services to first-time youth offenders and formerly incarcerated persons. By targeting first time offenders ages 17 - 24, we work to break the cycle of incarceration through a multi-pronged approach involving judges and court systems, community organizations, and churches. Oasis Center treats the whole person by providing wrap-around services, including job readiness, life coaching, job placement, and other faith-based programming to reduce the likelihood of returning to the system. Additionally, Oasis Center partners with members of the South Dallas Employment Project, which helps extend our impact and pursue reentry solutions through the lens of social equity.

### COMMUNITY

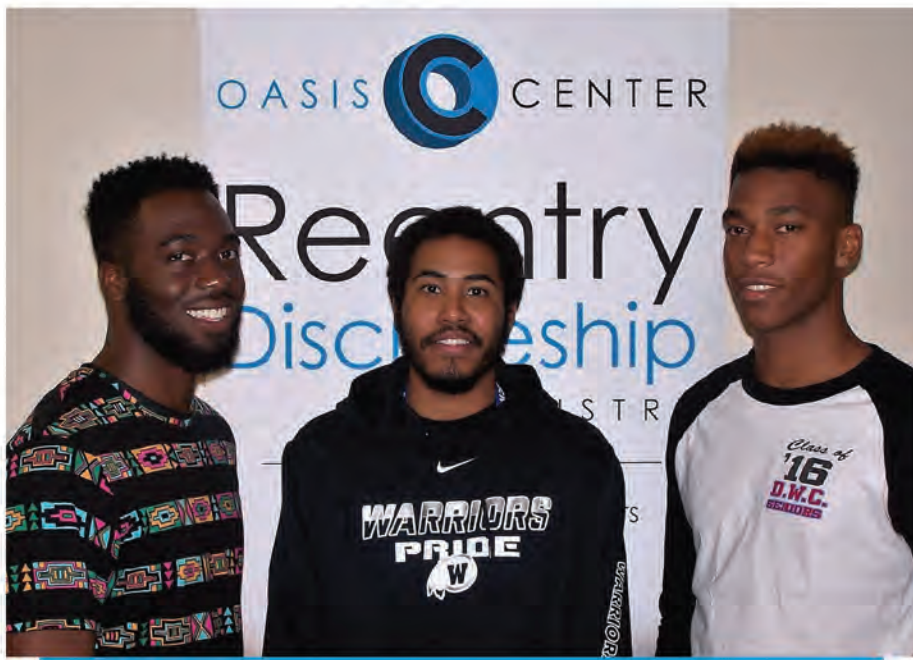
Oasis Center provides faith and community based organizations with the ability to expand their organization's capacity through a shared strategy and growing network.

## OUR PROGRAMS

### YOUNG ADULT OFFENDERS PROGRAM

For young adults ages 17 – 24 years of age who are experiencing their first brush with the criminal justice system and are facing a felony conviction, Oasis Center works with the Dallas District Attorney's AIM (Achieve Inspire and Motivate) Program. AIM is a 12-18-month program, which includes referrals to the Oasis Center Work Camp. Upon the completion of the AIM program, the participant is eligible to have his/her criminal charges expunged.

### JOB READINESS WORK CAMP

Oasis Center offers an in-person 5 day, 5 hours per day (9 am – 2 pm) training class. We also offer a less intense, transitional class for participants not needing the full work camp. The camp provides FREE classes in job readiness, life and cognitive skills, resume writing, job search assistance, and job placement with corporate partners. Paid internships and free vocational certification to qualified participants are available. Adult education, ESL and on-site low-energy training and placement are available.

### WORKFORCE PLACEMENT

The services of Oasis Center, in partnership with the South Dallas Employment Project, are now available to those pre-qualified members of the community with disabilities, veterans, under-employed and unemployed citizens involved within the criminal justice system. Our Mission is to provide life changing programs and services.
